



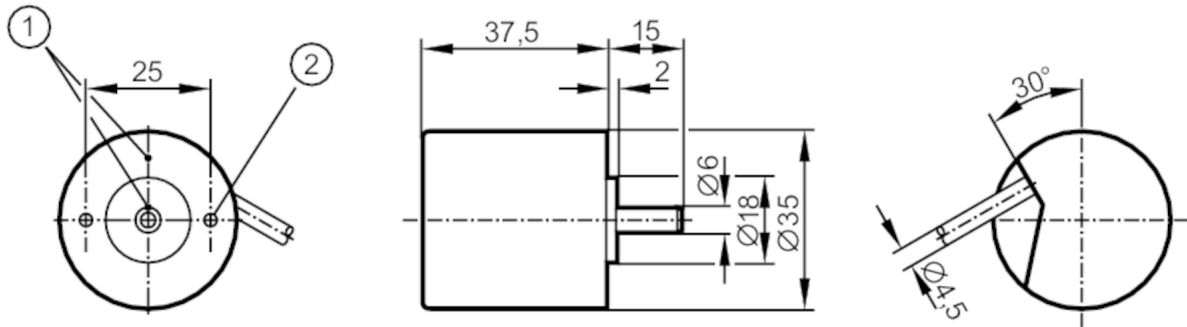

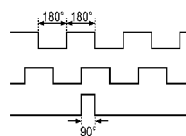
Electrical connection
